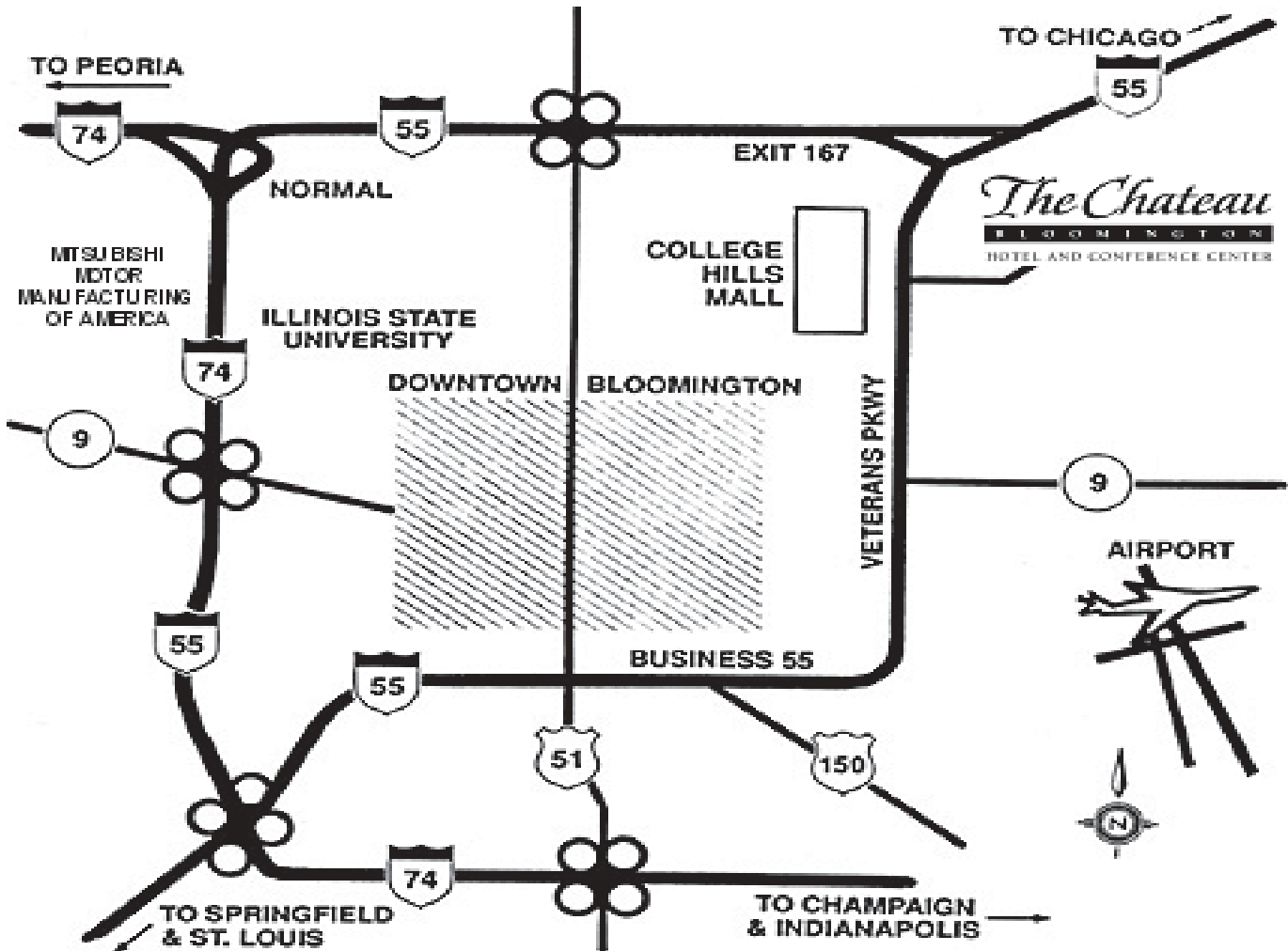

MAP TO HOTEL CHATEAU



From Chicago—140 miles

Take I-55 South to Veteran's Parkway South. The Chateau Hotel Conference Center is located on the corner of Veteran's Parkway and Jumer Drive, across from the College Hills Mall.

From St. Louis—156 miles

Take I-55 North to Veteran's Parkway North. The Chateau is located on the corner of Veteran's Parkway and Jumer Drive, across from the College Hills Mall.

From Peoria—38 miles

Take I-74 East to I-55 North to Veteran's Parkway South. The Chateau is located on the corner of Veteran's Parkway and Jumer Drive, across from the College Hills Mall.

From the Bloomington-Normal Airport

The airport is located on Route 9 West. Stay on Route 9 West to Veteran's Parkway and turn right. Go through 2-3 stoplights and the Chateau is on the right hand side.
